Is this course for me?

This course empowers aspiring entrepreneurs with the skills and confidence to successfully launch your small business. You will learn how to identify a business opportunity and assess its key components as well as research and develop a business plan. Given the technical nature of this course, we recommend participants have language, literacy and numeracy skills equivalent to Certificate III level.

This course is available to participants under Self-Employment Assistance program.

Eligibility

To be eligible for the Self-Employment Assistance program, you must:

- ✓ be at least 15 years of age;
- ✓ not be prohibited by law from working in Australia;
- ✓ not be an overseas visitor on a working holiday visa or an overseas student studying in Australia;
- ✓ not be an undischarged bankrupt; and
- ✓ not be enrolled in full-time secondary education

To check your eligibility, contact MTC FutureReady.

You will require the Language Literacy, Numeracy and Digital skills to:

- ✓ Conduct basic internet research.
- ✓ Engage in online learning, including video conferencing sessions.
- ✓ Create simple word-processed documents and spreadsheets.
- ✓ Read and comprehend simple written documents and numerical texts.

You must have access to:

- ✓ A computer or laptop.
- ✓ The internet.
- ✓ Word-processing software.

Course structure

This course is delivered online through Microsoft Teams and is scheduled for two (2) days a week for a total of four (4) weeks of structured training.

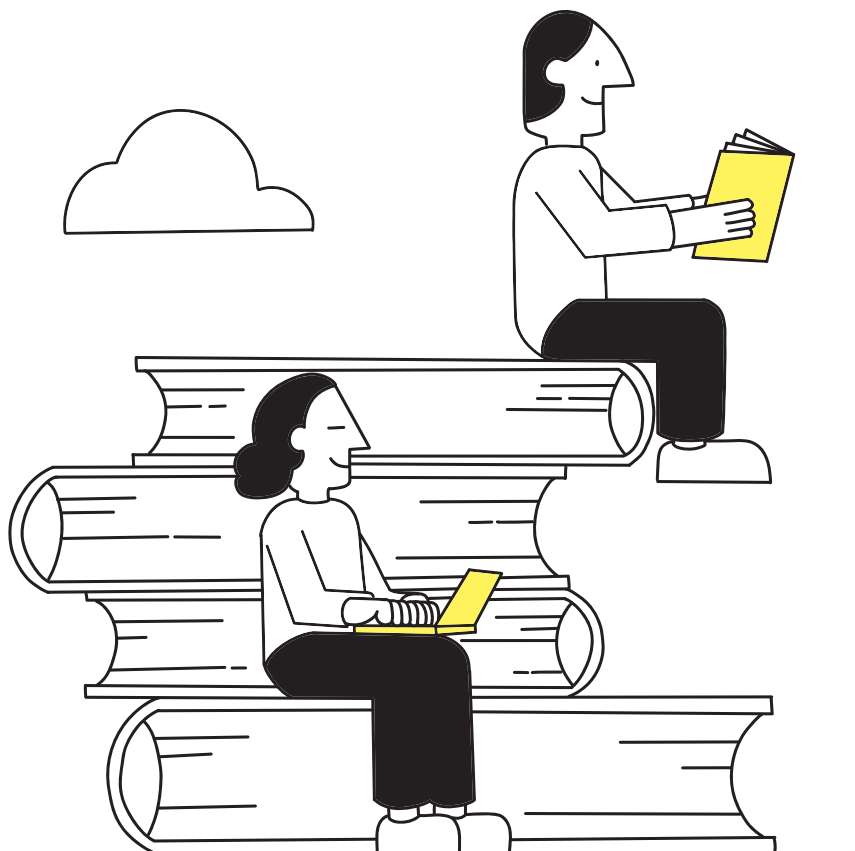
It will include:
